

MESSAGE - I CAN...

1. Add an interesting title to my writing when I need to				
2. Talk about who my audience is and why I am writing				
3. Support my main ideas with some details				
4. Put my story ideas in a good order				
5. Start my sentences in different ways				
6. Write for different purposes – to share my opinion, to describe something, to tell what has happened to me				
7. Use lots of different adjectives (describing words)				
8. Use some strong verbs e.g. <i>pounced</i> instead of <i>jumped</i>				

TOOLS - I CAN...

1. Use chunks I know, to help me spell words I don't know				
2. Spell most words from Lists 1 - 4 correctly				
3. Use full stops and capital letters in the right place				
4. Use a capital letter for people's names and places				
5. Use exclamation marks and question marks when I need to				
6. Join two ideas into one sentence using joining words like: 'and', 'but', 'so'				
7. Try to join two ideas together using joining words like: 'because', 'since', 'after', 'when', 'who', 'which'				

PROCESSES - I CAN...

1. Put the main ideas in my plan and then use my plan to help me write my ideas				
2. Re-read my writing to check that it makes sense				
3. Begin to edit my writing by adding, deleting or changing a word to make my writing better				
4. Proof read my writing by underlining words I think I may not have spelt right				
5. Proof read my writing by fixing my spelling mistakes using a dictionary				
6. Proof read my writing by adding in punctuation such as full stops or capital letters when I have forgotten them
